- 1. An Election is to be held for a Member of Parliament for the Reigate Constituency.

- 3. Completed nomination papers must be delivered to the Acting Returning Officer for the Reigate Constituency, Town Hall, Castlefield Road, Reigate, Surrey, RH2 0SH on any working day after the date of this notice, between the hours of 10 am and 4 pm, but no later than **4 pm on Friday**, **7th June 2024**.
- 4. The £500 deposit may be made either by the deposit of any legal tender, by means of a banker's draft, or the electronic transfer of funds.
- 5. If any election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday**, **4th July 2024**.
- Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Town Hall, Castlefield Road, Reigate, Surrey, RH2 0SH by 12 midnight on Tuesday, 18 June 2024. Applications can be made online: <u>www.gov.uk/register-to-vote</u>.
- 7. New postal vote applications, amendments or cancellations to existing postal votes, and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes, must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5 pm on Wednesday, 19th June 2024**.
- 8. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by **5 pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024**.
- Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5 pm on Wednesday, 19th June 2024. Applications can be made online: <u>https://www.gov.uk/apply-forphoto-id-voter-authority-certificate</u>.
- 10. The deadline for new applications to be received by the Electoral Registration Officer to vote by proxy on grounds of occupation, service or employment or a medical condition, illness or disability arising after 5pm on Wednesday, 26 June 2024 is not later than **5pm on Thursday, 4 July 2024**. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 26th June 2024.
